
Travel Day

Your step-by-step guide to arriving in Costa Rica and getting to Peace Retreat



Part 1 - Immigration

• Upon arrival, proceed to immigration.

• The wait time will vary based on the season, time of day, and day of week. Usually, Immigration takes 20-40 minutes. Wifi and restrooms are available in the area.

You'll need to show the immigration officer: your passport, the address of Peace Retreat (see below), and your return ticket showing your departure from Costa Rica within 180 days of arrival.

Part 2 - Baggage Claim

- After Immigration, proceed to the baggage claim area to pick up your luggage.
- Restrooms are also available in this area.
- Retrieve your luggage and proceed to the Agricultural Enforcement line.
- Place all luggage through the scanner and then proceed to the exit.

Part 3 - Find Your Driver

- Once in the Arrivals Terminal, proceed outside through the main sliding glass doors. Once outside, look for the driver holding a *Peace Retreat* sign.
- There will be many other drivers and tour operators who will attempt to carry your luggage for a tip or sell you other taxi services. We encourage you to engage only with the Peace Retreat driver.
- If for any reason, you arrive early or cannot locate your driver, please proceed to the outdoor sitting area of the airport cafe. The cafe is to the left after you exit the terminal. Our drivers have been instructed to check this location in the event of separation.
- Should you have any issues finding your driver, please reach out to us via WhatsApp.

Part 4 - Drive To Peace Retreat

- The drive time is approximately 75-minutes to Peace Retreat from Liberia Airport.
- We work with a small group of drivers who are all fantastic and will take good care of you.
- Tips are not required but are encouraged. A standard tip ranges from USD\$10-\$20.

FAQs

- Should I exchange my USD for colones at the airport? Not necessary, most restaurants and vendors in Costa Rica accept USD currency. However, if you'd like to have colones, there is a currency exchange in the airport, just past Immigration.
- What if I can't find the Peace Retreat Driver? Please proceed to the cafe sitting area outside the Arrivals Terminal and contact us immediately (see Part 3)
- Can my driver make stops on the way to Peace Retreat? Yes, if requested. There are a few places to stop and buy drinks, snacks and groceries on the way. Just let your driver know of your needs, and be conscious of your fellow travelers who may be tired and eager to arrive to Peace Retreat.
